

Changes to Argus Documentation effective 01 September 2009

LatestModuleDetails.csv

Argus is introducing two additional fields to the LatestModuleDetails.csv documentation file. These fields will be the Module Content Start Date and Module Content End date.

Blank (null) start or end dates mean the records are active in the module. Explicit dates are the first or last date the record was available in the module.

LatestTimestamp.csv

Argus is adding a new Timestamp to the list of available timestamps. The new time stamp is Houston midday, it will have value TS = 27 (Please note, this time stamp will be added to the system sooner but will not be actively used until 1 September).

LatestModules.csv

Argus is changing the time at which the DHC data module is created. The time is being moved forwards 30 minutes from 21:00 EST to 20:30 EST. This change makes the Argus US crude data online 30 minutes sooner than currently available. These times follow summer time daylight savings changes.
